



ARTICULATION AGREEMENT between HOWARD COMMUNITY COLLEGE JAMES W. ROUSE SCHOLARS PROGRAM and UNIVERSITY OF BALTIMORE HELEN P. DENIT HONORS PROGRAM

Introduction

This document establishes a formal articulation agreement between Howard Community College's James W. Rouse Scholars Program and the Helen P. Denit Honors Program of the University of Baltimore. It is based upon a thorough review and analysis of the James W. Rouse Scholars' curriculum at Howard Community College in relation to the requirements for a Bachelor's Degree. This agreement will facilitate the admission of Rouse Scholars and the transferability of their academic credits from Howard Community College to the University of Baltimore's Bachelor's Degree program.

ACADEMIC AGREEMENTS

- Rouse Scholars transfer students in good academic standing at Howard Community College with a 3.5 minimum cumulative grade point average will be admitted to the Helen P. Denit Honors Program.
- All credit earned in the Rouse Scholars academic core curriculum will transfer to the University of Baltimore. College courses completed beyond the core will be articulated based on the Rouse Scholars' academic major.
- In those cases where a Rouse Scholar does not meet the minimum academic qualifications, credit hour requirements, or specific school/college stipulations for admissions as specified above, the receiving institution will retain the authority to consider additional academic and other credentials of its choosing to determine eligibility for admission.

• The Helen P. Denit Honors Program agrees to offer one Wilson Scholarship (with an enhancement of \$1000) per year to a transferring Rouse Scholar. The enhancement will be for two full-time years (pro-rated for part-time enrollment) and will remain in effect as long as the student remains in good standing with the Helen P. Denit Honors Program. Recipients of this scholarship enhancement will be at the discretion of the Rouse Scholars Program.

This agreement becomes effective upon signature by all parties and shall continue in effect unless voided by either party upon sixty (60) days prior written notice. Howard Community College and the University of Baltimore will consider, in good faith, any amendments proposed by either party; however, the Agreement may only be amended in writing, signed by both parties.
